AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 8-58 TO EXTEND ONE WAY PARKING ON ADAMS STREET NORTH TO CROSS STREET AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NELSONVILLE, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 8-58 be amended to extend one side parking as it presently provides, north on Adams Street to the north side of the Cross Street intersection.

Section 2. For the reason that two-side parking on the above section of Adams Street interferes with the movement of traffic on that street, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency ordinance necessary for the public health, peace, and safety, and shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 8-58 TO EXTEND ONE WAY PARKING ON ADAMS STREET NORTH TO CROSS STREET; TO LIMIT ONE WAY PARKING BETWEEN FRANKLIN STREET AND WASHINGTON STREET ON ADAMS STREET; AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NELSONVILLE, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Ordinance no. 8-58 be amended to extend one side parking as it presently provides, north on Adams Street to the north side of the Cross Street intersection.

Section 2. That Ordinance no. 8-58 be amended to limit one side parking between Franklin Street and Washington Street on Adams Street to: Between the hours of 7:00 o'clock A.M. and 5:00 o'clock P.M. Monday through Friday only; thereafter to permit two side parking.

Section 3. For the reason that the parking situation on Adams Street creates a traffic hazard, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the public peace, health and safety, and shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

AN ORDINANCE CREATING PERMANENT LOADING ZONES ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF FAYETTE STREET AT THE HOCKING STREET INTERSECTION AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NELSONVILLE, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the temporary loading zone on the south side of Fayette Street extending east from the Hocking Street intersection a distance of 80 feet be made a permanent loading zone between the hours of 8:00 A.M. o'clock A.M. and 5:00 o'clock P.M.

Section 2. For the reason that there is a traffic problem in the area, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the public peace, health, and safety, and shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

Be It ordained by the City Council of the City of Nelsonville State of Ohio:


Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate any vehicle except in a northerly direction on the Presbyterian Church Alley between Columbus Street and Washington Street.

AN ORDINANCE LIMITING PARKING ON MYERS STREET: AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NELSONVILLE, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That parking be prohibited on Myers Street on the south side, from the Canal Street intersection at the western extreme of said Street, for 77 feet in an easterly direction.

Section 2. That parking be prohibited on Myers Street on the north side, from the Canal Street intersection at the western extreme of said Street, for 66 feet in an easterly direction.

Section 3. For the reason that two side parking in this area on Myers Street creates a traffic hazard, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency ordinance necessary for the public peace, health and safety, and shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1169 TO INCREASE THE RATE FOR WATER SOLD OUTSIDE THE CITY LIMITS OF NELSONVILLE, AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NELSONVILLE, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 1169 which regulates the rate for water sold outside the City Limits of Nelsonville be amended to increase said rate from ten per cent (10%) more than the rate for water sold within the city limits of Nelsonville to fifty per cent (50%) more than the rate for water sold within the city limits of Nelsonville.

Section 2. For the reason that the present rate is not a fair return on the investment of the City of Nelsonville in providing such water and making the same available outside the City Limits of Nelsonville, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency ordinance necessary for the public peace, health, and safety, and shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
