AN ORDINANCE DECLARING A REAL AND PRESENT EMERGENCY ARISING IN CONNECTION WITH THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE; AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY-SERVICE DIRECTOR TO CONTRACT WITH TRAFWAY, INCORPORATED, FOR THE INSTALLATION OF TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES AT THE INTERSECTION OF WASHINGTON STREET AND THE PUBLIC SQUARE IN NELSONVILLE, OHIO; AND APPROPRIATING \$15,320.00 FROM THE BAIRD STUART FUND FOR THE PURPOSES OF PURCHASING THE TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES FROM TRAFWAY, INC., FOR THE INTERSECTION OF WASHINGTON STREET AND THE PUBLIC SQUARE IN NELSONVILLE, OHIO; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NELSONVILLE, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That in accordance with Section 735.051, Revised Code, a case of real and present emergency arising with the operation and maintenance of the Department of Public Service is hereby declared.

Section 2. The Safety-Service Director be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Trafway, Inc., for the installation of traffic control devices at the intersection of Washington Street and the Public Square, Nelsonville, Ohio.

Section 3. That the sum of \$15,320.00 be and it is hereby appropriated from the Baird Stuart Fund to compensate Trafway, Inc. for the installation of the traffic control devices to be constructed and erected at the intersection of Washington Street and the Public Square in Nelsonville, Ohio.

Section 4. This measure is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Nelsonville, Ohio, for the reason that the existing traffic control device at the intersection of Washington Street and the Public Square in Nelsonville, Ohio, are in a deteriorated condition and therefore, this measure shall take effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE PAYMENT OF WATER CHARGES; PROVIDING THAT WATER SERVICE SHALL BE DENIED TO DELINQUENT WATER USERS OR FOR PREMISES THAT HAVE INCURRED DELINQUENT WATER SERVICE CHARGES; INCORPORATING CURRENT WATER SERVICE RATES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NELSONVILLE, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION I:

RESPONSIBILITY OF PROPERTY OWNER FOR WATER SERVICES CHARGES

(A) When a person other than a property owner makes application for water service, the property owner shall sign the application along with the applicant, and both parties shall be held jointly and severally responsible for the payment of water charges. Unless otherwise specified, water bills will be rendered to the applicant only, but the property owner will be notified if a bill for water charges is delinquent more than 30 days.

(B) Where more than one occupant or tenant is served through one meter the property owner will be held directly responsible for the payment of all bills pertaining to the use of water.

SECTION II:

WATER SERVICE WILL BE DENIED TO DELINQUENT USERS

No water shall be supplied to any applicant who is delinquent for more than 30 days in the payment of water bills, or who is indebted to the water department for material, supplies or work done, or in any other manner, until such indebtedness has been paid, whether that indebtedness was incurred at the premises for which service is supplied or at any other place within or without the city; and the water department reserves to itself the right to shut off the water from the premises of such applicant so delinquent upon 48 hours notice.

SECTION III:

WATER SERVICE CHARGES

All current water service charges of the City of Nelsonville, Ohio prescribed by Ordinance, be and they are hereby incorporated herein.

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$32,000.00 FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF RESURFACING CLINTON, OAK, AND SCOTT STREETS, SEALING FAYETTE, COLUMBUS, AND FRANKLIN STREETS, REPAIRING THE RAILROAD CROSSINGS AT CANAL AND CHESTNUT STREETS, BUILDING A CATCH BASIN ON LOVE STREET AND POPLAR STREET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NELSONVILLE, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION I. That the sum of \$32,000.00 be and it is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund for the purpose of resurfacing <sup>improvement,</sup> Clinton, Oak and Scott Streets, sealing Fayette, Columbus, and Franklin Streets, repairing the railroad crossings at Canal and Chestnut Streets, building a catch basin on Love Street and Poplar Street.

SECTION II. This measure is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the Citizens of Nelsonville, Ohio for the reason that the above-named streets are in need of emergency repair due to their condition and therefore, this measure shall take effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

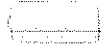
