**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2008 APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE LOAN PROCEEDS ON THE ADAMS-CROSS & LOVE STREETS PROJECT PHASE II.**

WHEREAS, adjustments need to be made to the 2008 Appropriations Ordinance to appropriate loan proceeds on the Adams-Cross & Love Streets project Phase II;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NELSONVILLE, ATHENS COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The 2008 Appropriations Ordinance is amended to appropriate the following:

Forty-seven Thousand Dollars (\$47,000.00) from the unappropriated balance of the Water Fund #700 to line item #700-730-7020 Water Capital Project by Loan, Forty-seven Thousand Dollars (\$47,000.00) from the unappropriated balance of the Sewer Fund #750 to line item #750-770-70020 Sewer Capital Projects by Loan, and Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00) from the unappropriated balance of the Street Construction Fund #200 to line item #200-150-70020 Street Projects by Loan.

2. The total appropriations are increased by said amount.

3. This Ordinance shall become effective at the earliest date provided by law.

WHEREAS, The City of Nelsonville has decide to provide free holiday shopping parking for the period from December 15 through December 27, 2008 on the following streets: West Columbus Street, East Columbus Street, West Washington Street, East Washington Street, Hocking Parkway, September Street, Fort Street, and the Public Square.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NELSONVILLE, ATHENS COUNTY, OHIO:

- 1. The City of Nelsonville, Ohio authorizes the City Manager to provide free holiday shopping parking for the period from December 1 through December 27, 2008 on the following streets:

## ORDINANCE 53-08

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2008 APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL FUNDS AND ALLOWING THE AUDITOR TO PLACE THE FUNDS IN LINE ITEMS AS NEEDED FOR YEAR END APPROPRIATIONS.**

**WHEREAS**, adjustments need to be made to the 2008 Appropriations Ordinance for the purpose of appropriating additional funds for year end expenditures, and it is best to allow the city auditor to place the funds in line items as needed;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NELSONVILLE, ATHENS COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The 2008 Appropriations Ordinance is amended to appropriate the following:
  - a. Twenty-four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$24,500.00) from the unappropriated balance of the General Fund #100 to various lines within fund #100 as deemed necessary by the City Auditor to meet year end expenditures.
  - b. Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) from the unappropriated balance of the Street Levy Fund #230 to various lines within fund #230 as deemed necessary by the City Auditor to meet year end expenditures.
  - c. Three Hundred Twenty-five Dollars (\$325.00) from the unappropriated balance of the Recreation Levy Fund #300 to various lines within fund #300 as deemed necessary by the City Auditor to meet year end expenditures.
  - d. Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) from the unappropriated balance of the Street Light Levy Fund # 350 to various lines within fund #350 as deemed necessary by the City Auditor to meet year end expenditures.
  - e. Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) from the unappropriated balance of the Water Fund #700 to various lines within fund #700 as deemed necessary by the City Auditor to meet year end expenditures.
  - f. Seventeen Thousand Dollars (\$17,000.00) from the unappropriated balance of the Sewer Fund #750 to various lines within fund #750 as deemed necessary by the City Auditor to meet year end expenditures.
  - g. One Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$1,900.00) from the unappropriated balance of the Parking Meter Fund #825 to various lines within fund #825 as deemed necessary by the City Auditor to meet year end expenditures.
  - h. Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) from the unappropriated balance of the Baird Stuart/Nelsonville Honor Roll Fund #850 to various lines within fund #850 as deemed necessary by the City Auditor to meet year end expenditures.




WHEREAS, Rumpke submitted the lowest and best bid for residential garbage collection in the City of Nelsonville;
