

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE OHIO PUBLIC EMPLOYEES DEFERRED COMPENSATION PROGRAM IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RESOLUTION ATTACHED HERETO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in 1974 the Ohio Legislature created the Ohio Public Employees Deferred Compensation Program to provide public employees with an additional way to save for retirement; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Public Employees Deferred Compensation Program is similar to a 401(k) or a 403(b) plan, but does not have sales charges, commissions, back-end loads or other sales expenses associated with those plans; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Public Employees Deferred Compensation Program provides a tax advantage to public employees; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Public Employees Deferred Compensation Program provides Public Employees investment options with flexible withdrawal options; and


WHEREAS, there is no cost to the City of Nelsonville for the Program other than providing payroll deduction;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NELSONVILLE, ATHENS COUNTY, OHIO:


1. The Resolution attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, adopting the Ohio Public Employees Deferred Compensation Program is adopted.

This Resolution is being passed as an emergency measure pursuant to O.R.C. 731.30 because the immediate passage of the Ordinance is necessary because the program has been available since 1974 and immediate passage will allow employees to participate at a sooner date, and this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption.

A RESOLUTION PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED CODE 5705.03 (B) REQUESTING THE ATHENS COUNTY AUDITOR TO CERTIFY THE AMOUNT OF REVENUES GENERATED BY A 2 MILL REPLACEMENT LEVY FOR GENERAL CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, RESURFACING, AND REPAIR OF STREETS, ROADS, AND BRIDGES (OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 5705.19 (G) TO BE PLACED ON THE BALLOT AT THE NOVEMBER 4, 2014 GENERAL ELECTION AS A REPLACEMENT LEVY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the current street levy for the general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges (Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.19 (G) is due to expire on December 31, 2014;

WHEREAS, the City of Nelsonville is in need of said funds to adequately construct, reconstruct, resurface, and repair the streets, roads, and bridges located within the City of Nelsonville;

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.03 (B) requires the City of Nelsonville to request the Athens County Auditor to certify the amount of revenues generated by the replacement of the City's 2 mill levy expiring in 2014, as a prerequisite to placing the issue on the ballot;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NELSONVILLE, ATHENS COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That the Clerk of Council shall certify a copy of this Resolution to the Athens County Auditor requesting the Athens County Auditor to certify to the City of Nelsonville the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the replacement of a five year 2 mill levy outside the ten mill limitation for the general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.19 (G) to be placed on the ballot for the November 4, 2014, General Election, and to run for a term of five years commencing January 1, 2015 as a Replacement Levy if approved by the voters
2. The Clerk of Council is directed to deliver a copy of this Resolution to the Athens County Auditor.
3. This Resolution is being passed as an emergency measure pursuant to O.R.C. 731.30 because the immediate passage of the Resolution is necessary because the County Auditor must certify the funds to be collected prior to adoption of a Resolution placing the issue on the ballot and the date for placing the issue on the ballot is August 6, 2014.

A RESOLUTION PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED CODE 5705.03 (B) REQUESTING THE ATHENS COUNTY AUDITOR TO CERTIFY THE AMOUNT OF REVENUES GENERATED BY A 2 MILL RENEWAL LEVY FOR GENERAL CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, RESURFACING, AND REPAIR OF STREETS, ROADS, AND BRIDGES (OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 5705.19 (G) TO BE PLACED ON THE BALLOT AT THE NOVEMBER 4, 2014 GENERAL ELECTION AS A RENEWAL LEVY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the current street levy for the general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges (Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.19 (G) is due to expire on December 31, 2014;

WHEREAS, the City of Nelsonville is in need of said funds to adequately construct, reconstruct, resurface, and repair the streets, roads, and bridges located within the City of Nelsonville;


WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.03 (B) requires the City of Nelsonville to request the Athens County Auditor to certify the amount of revenues generated by the renewal of the City's 2 mill levy expiring in 2014, as a prerequisite to placing the issue on the ballot;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NELSONVILLE, ATHENS COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That the Clerk of Council shall certify a copy of this Resolution to the Athens County Auditor requesting the Athens County Auditor to certify to the City of Nelsonville the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the renewal of a five year 2 mill levy outside the ten mill limitation for the general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.19 (G) to be placed on the ballot for the November 4, 2014, General Election, and to run for a term of five years commencing January 1, 2015 as a Renewal Levy if approved by the voters
2. The Clerk of Council is directed to deliver a copy of this Resolution to the Athens County Auditor
3. This Resolution is being passed as an emergency measure pursuant to O.R.C. 731.30 because the immediate passage of the Resolution is necessary because the County Auditor must certify the funds to be collected prior to adoption of a Resolution placing the issue on the ballot and the date for placing the issue on the ballot is August 6, 2014.

RESOLUTION 2154

A RESOLUTION PLACING THE FIVE YEAR RENEWAL OF A 2 MILL STREET LEVY ON THE BALLOT AT THE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 4, 2014 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the 2 mill Street Levy is due to expire in 2014; and

WHEREAS, the taxes that will be raised within the ten-mill limitation will be insufficient to provide for the necessary requirements of Nelsonville City, and therefore, it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of that limitation for general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges, and street and road maintenance pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.19 (G);

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NELSONVILLE, ATHENS COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:


1. The taxes that will be raised within the ten-mill limitation will be insufficient to provide for the necessary requirements of Nelsonville City, and therefore, it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of that limitation for general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges, and street and road maintenance, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.19 (G).
2. The Resolution attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference placing the issue of the renewal of the 2 mill Street Levy on the November 4, 2014 General Election ballot is adopted.
3. The Clerk is directed to deliver a certified copy of this Resolution and attachment to the Athens County Board of Elections prior to ninety days before November 4, 2014.
4. This Resolution is being passed as an emergency measure pursuant to O.R.C. 731.30 and shall be effective upon its adoption because the adoption of this Resolution placing the issue on the ballot must be certified to the Board of Elections by August 6, 2014 and therefore the thirty (30) wait period needs to be waived.



WHEREAS, *Section 7, Article XVIII* of the *Ohio Constitution* establishes home rule and thus permits a charter municipality to exercise any power and perform any function necessary for conducting its affairs and directing its governance; and

WHEREAS, the City of Nelsonville is committed to protecting and enhancing environmental quality in Athens County now and for future generations; and

WHEREAS, the placement of materials in waste disposal facilities, such as landfills and incinerators, is costly to taxpayers, causes damage to ecosystem health, wastes natural resources, and transfers liabilities to future generation; and

WHEREAS, an estimated 72,000 tons of waste is generated in Athens and Hocking County each year by residents, businesses, and institutions, and approximately 85% of this amount is sent for landfill disposal; and

WHEREAS, a resource recovery-based economy will create and sustain more productive and meaningful jobs; and

WHEREAS, waste prevention, reuse, recycling, and composting are material management options that conserve resources while reducing environmental impacts; and

WHEREAS, through the application of various programs and policies, the majority of resources can be recovered; and

WHEREAS, with the acknowledgment that government must lead by example by establishing criteria needed to eliminate waste; and



NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Nelsonville, Athens County, Ohio that:


1. The City of Nelsonville, Ohio supports the implementation of the Athens Hocking Zero Waste Action Plan dated December 2013.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Nelsonville City Council that:


